SENIOR EXAM SCHEDULE

Friday, May 18th – Seniors take their 8th bell exam from 1:06-2:40 in the math lab. **This is a normal day of school.**

- Each exam will be a double bell, or approximately 90 minutes.
- Seniors only have to report if they have an exam. Once a senior is finished with exams for the day, they can leave. However, they must stay for the entire exam bell.
- We **DO** exempt students from exams of year-long course if they achieve an A average before the final. A teacher must give permission for a student to be exempt from an exam.

Tuesday, May 22nd – 3rd bell exam 7:45 – 9:18; 4th bell exam is 9:54 – 11:27

Wednesday, May 23rd – 6th bell exam 7:45 – 9:18; 7th bell exam 9:21- 10:54

Thursday, May 24th – No formal school for seniors

- Graduation practice at the College of Mount St. Joseph. All seniors will report to Purcell Marian at 10:00 am. The buses will depart for Mount St. Joe at 10:00 am. Students will return to school at 12:30 pm.
- Caps and gowns will be distributed after the practice. ***IF A STUDENT IS NOT AT THE GRADUATION PRACTICE, HE OR SHE WILL NOT RECEIVE THEIR CAP AND GOWN.***
- Senior Circle: 7:00 pm – 9:00 pm in Alumni Hall
