Walking Requirements

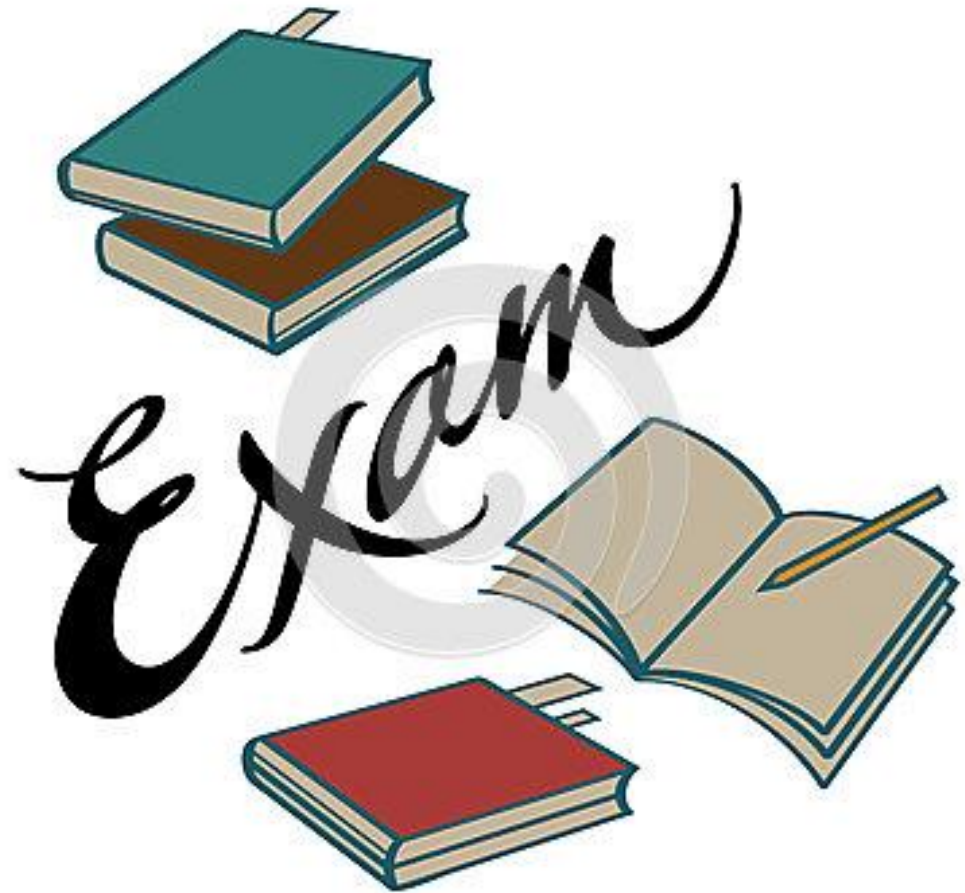
If your financial obligations are not completed by this date, your student will not be allowed to graduate, and transcripts will be placed on hold.
