



## 2018 Summer School Information

### **WHEN:**

- June 13<sup>th</sup> – July 3<sup>rd</sup> from 8:00 am – 12:00 pm
- Attendance is required until a student completes the assigned work successfully.

### **WHERE:**

- Purcell Marian Summer School will be held in the Social Studies Lab

### **WHO:**

- Only Purcell Marian students will be able to take summer school at Purcell Marian. We will no longer accept students from other high schools.
- Four teachers will be on staff throughout the summer school program to assist students.

### **HOW:**

- Purcell Marian students will be assigned summer school if they failed a class for the year.
- A student will be able to take at most two classes during one summer school period.
- Students who fail more than two classes will not be promoted to the next grade level and will be given the choice to repeat the same grade or transfer schools.
- Purcell Marian summer school is for credit recovery only.
- Students will be assigned work based on their areas of weaknesses displayed throughout the course. The main objective of our summer school program will be to re-teach, and then re-assess these areas.
- Freshmen will work with a number of traditional classroom materials, while sophomores, juniors, and seniors will be completing their work via an online course.

### **COST:**

- Cost \$300 per class, with a maximum of two classes per summer school period.

### **REGISTRATION:**
